RESOLUTION NO. 87

Offered by Public Works & Services Committee

Relating to Authorization to Amend an Inter-Municipal
 Agreement With the Village of Malone

WHEREAS: On April 24, 2024, The Village of Malone and Franklin County Government entered into an Inter-Municipal Agreement for the demolition of The Flanagan Hotel located at the corner of East Main Street and Elm Street Malone, New York; and

WHEREAS: Due to the ongoing deterioration of the adjacent building located at 411-417 East Main Street, it is necessary to include that building within the agreement; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED: That Franklin County Legislature hereby agrees to amend the Inter-Municipal Agreement with the Village of Malone to include the demolition of the building located at 411-417 East Main Street Malone, New York, with the details and terms outlined in the agreement.

Motion was made by Legislator Lockwood and seconded by Legislator Sparks. Chairman Janisewski requested that a roll call vote be taken. Clerk Marlow called the roll. Resolution defeated by 3 nays, 3 ayes and 1 abstention.
