The Board of Education endorses the use of assessment standards and examinations as a means to gauge student competency levels. In accordance with Commissioner's Regulations, the following requirements will be used for satisfactory completion of a local diploma.

Students who first enter grade nine through September 2004 will be eligible for a local or Regents diploma. For purposes of a Regents endorsed diploma a score of 65 in the Comprehensive English Exam, a Regents Mathematics Exam, a Regents Science Exam, the Regents United States History and Government Exam and the Regents Global Studies Exam shall be considered passing. A score of 55 will meet the local diploma requirements in these subjects

Students with disabilities will be eligible to meet local diploma requirements by passing Regents Competency Exams if they score less than 55 on the Regents Exams.
